Monash University Sunway Malaysia Campus

Mission

Sunway was Monash University's first international campus. Located 18 kilometres from central Kuala Lumpur, we have more than 5000 students. Sunway has a vibrant, global atmosphere - about one quarter of the student body is international. Monash University was invited by the Malaysian government to open a campus in 1998. Through a long-standing partnership with the Sunway Group, the first foreign university campus in Malaysia was created at Bandar Sunway in Petaling Jaya. Classes commenced in July 1998.

The current campus was purpose-built in 2007 at a cost of some RM200m. At present there are some 5,100 students and 500 staff, with growth projected to lead to over 6,000 students and 600 staff. About one quarter of the student body is international. The campus continues to develop steadily, and now enjoys excellent facilities for world-class education and research. All academic staff members are expected to engage in scholarly research.

The management of Monash Sunway Campus finds that it is a need to equip the campus with digital signage network to keep the population up to date of the events and activities. This initiative will be carried out in stages with first phase installation in the library.

The requirement set by the IT team on the adoption of the digital signage solution include: -

- (b) 99% uptime with simple reset
